It's time for some improv! First, let's generate a list of scenes. Examples might include:

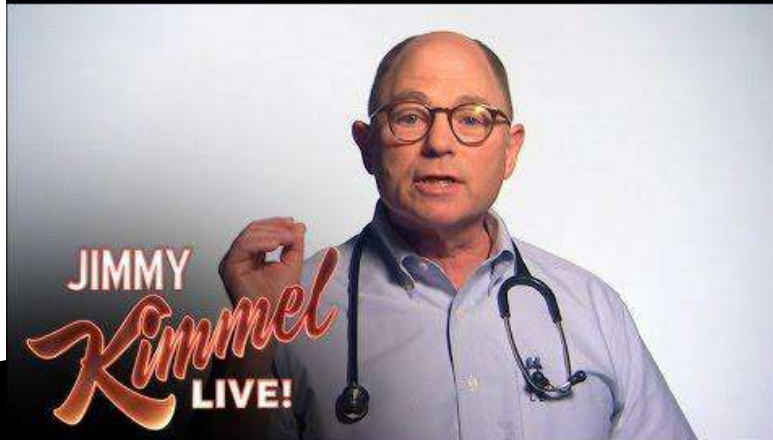
- × In the cereal aisle at the grocery store

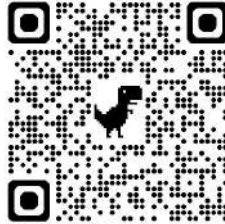
