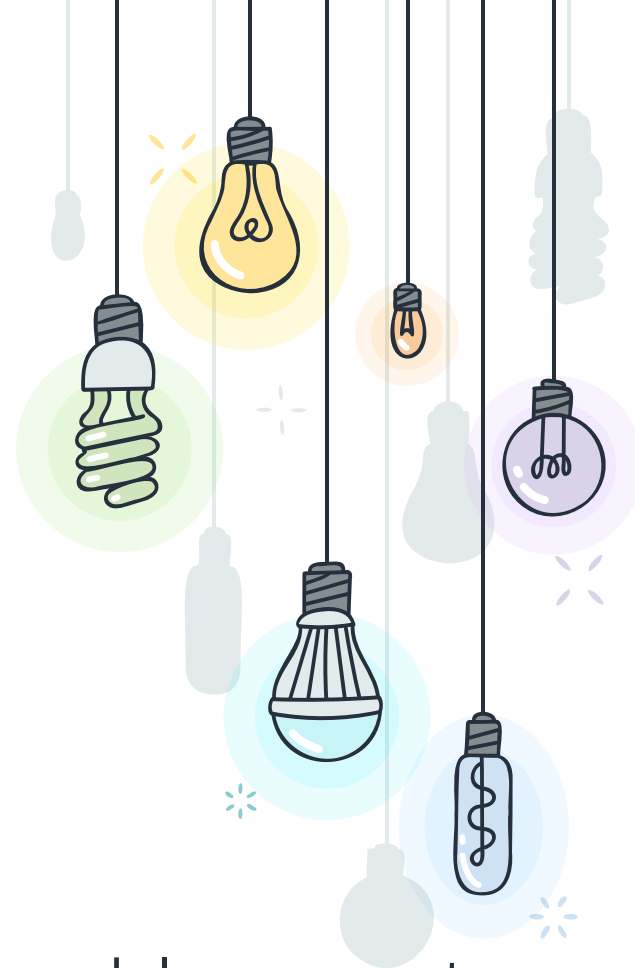

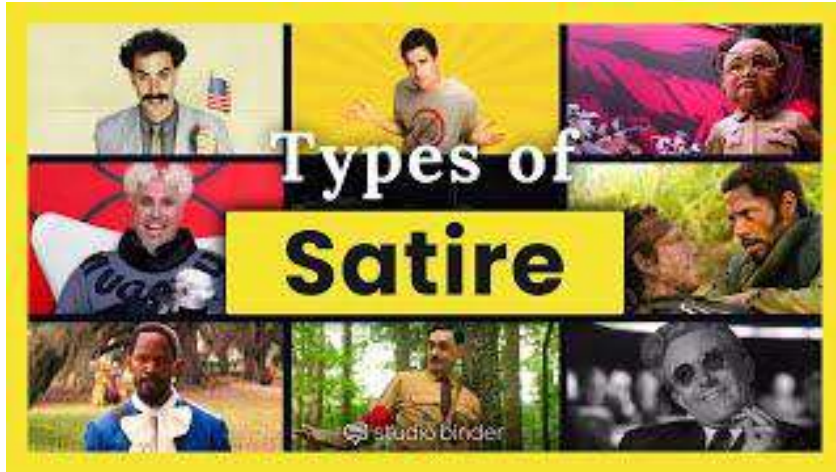
ACTING WARM UP: 2 LINES

Then it's time to let the fun begin.

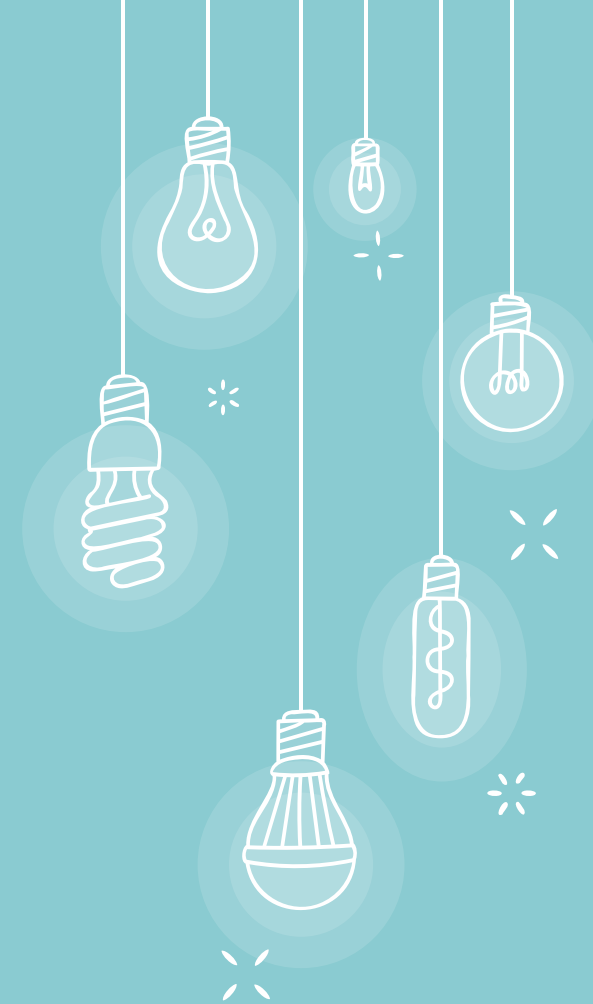




Satire vs. Sarcasm

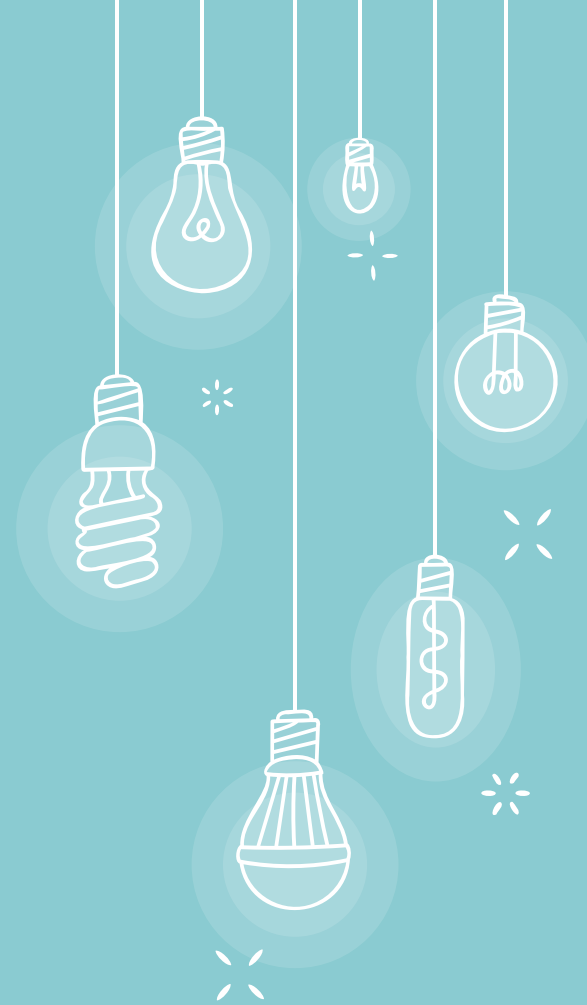


What if we treated teachers like professional athletes? Take a look at this skit and discuss the satire used here. What kinds of critiques are being made about the way teachers are viewed by society?

CHOOSE YOUR CATEGORY

First, you must decide what category to put yourself in:

- **Solo Acting**
- **Duet Acting (2 people)**
- **Small Group (3-5 people)**

Your speech piece must meet the following criteria:

- **Title, author, and your name spoken at start**
- **Appropriate content (rated PG-13 or below)**
- **Length: Between 1 and 3 minutes**

If showtime allows, you may do more than one piece in different categories or do various commercials.



SHOWCASE PRODUCTION

Our showcase will be student led. This means we will need students to take on the following roles:

Host: People to host the show (2)

Director: People who help write the skit for the hosts after completing their own showcase presentation piece (2)


Crew: Manage any chairs or tables which may need to come on or off stage. (2-3)

Other Opportunities:

Playbill Design: Design the cover for the program handed out to the audience

Greeter: Hand out programs and greet the audience as they arrive

Warm Up Leader: Lead class in vocal warm ups on showcase night while Mrs. C speaks to parents
