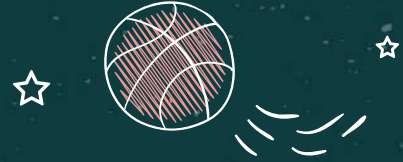


# ☆ ✨ EDUCATIONAL WEBSITES
